Features

Your Fillmaster UV dispenser features a touchscreen user interface, barcode scanning, a database containing water volume amounts for 20,000 unique medications, an automated water dispensing system, and an integrated UV reactor to control bacteria.




Ultraviolet Technology

The built-in ultraviolet reactor kills bacteria and viruses at the point of dispensing while the integrated water filtration system eliminates contaminants and conductivity, ensuring the water you dispense is always of the highest quality.

Ultraviolet (UV) water disinfection technology has become an increasingly popular tool in water treatment over the past three decades, due in part to its ability to provide treatment without the use of harmful chemicals. UV represents wavelengths that fall between visible light and x-ray on the electromagnetic spectrum.

The UV range can be further divided into UV-A, UV-B, UV-C, and Vacuum-UV. The UV-C portion represents wavelengths from 200 nm – 280 nm, which is the wavelength range used in our LED disinfection products. UV-C photons penetrate cells and damage the nucleic acid, rendering them incapable of reproduction, or microbiologically inactive.

Getting started with your Fillmaster UV

Getting Started

- Flush filters before first use. For Reverse Osmosis systems: Flush the first tank of water. See install guide for complete instructions.
- Install SD card before powering on device. Secure SD card in the slot. Slot is located under the top cover towards the back (machine will come with SD partially inserted but only operates if SD card pushed in completely).
- Plug in machine for power, turn on/off switch to "ON" position.
 Both located under the top cover.
- 4. Be sure that the water supply is turned on at all valves.
- 5. Attach the dispensing tip.
- Purge the dispenser. To begin purge, press "Menu" on the touch screen, then select "Dispense Water" which allows you to enter 100mL. Collect water and repeat until water runs clear. Repeating is common.
- 7. Calibrate the unit. See instructions on how to calibrate the unit.

How to Calibrate

- 1. Press "Menu" on the touch screen.
- 2. Select "Calibration."
- Place a graduated cylinder under dispensing tip and follow directions shown on screen

Scanning

- Hold the barcode about 3 inches away and parallel to the window on the scanner and move it side to side.
- Do NOT cover the barcode on the stock bottle with the prescription label.
- Check the display screen to confirm the drug.
- To enter NDC numbers directly without scanning, press "NDC" on the touch screen and enter all 11 digits of the NDC.

Troubleshooting & Maintenance

You see this screen

Medication NDC not found. Call Fillmaster at 888-284-7873.

Solution: The NDC for this drug is not yet in our database. We need to add it. Call **Fillmaster** for immediate assistance at 1-888-284-7873.

You see this screen

No water detected. Process canceled. Call Fillmaster technician at 888-284-7873.

Solution: Water is not reaching the machine. You can check the water supply line for kinks and make sure that all the valves are turned on. Or you can call us and we'll walk you through troubleshooting steps.

You have a leak

Best to just give us a call at 1-888-284-7873

Maintenance of your Fillmaster UV

- Calibrate the Fillmaster UV at least monthly.
- The Fillmaster UV™ should be cleaned regularly with mild soap and a damp cloth.
- Rinse the removable dispensing tip daily.
- · Replace dispensing tips monthly.
